- Timing can be full-time (40 hours/week) for 4 weeks; half-time for 8 weeks; or something equivalent
- CREWS will pay the \$4000 stipend (½ up front and ½ upon completion)

- 1. Name of the private/NGO/agency partner for the workforce development internship and a brief description of the nature of the internship, including the problem/project, and key outcomes/deliverables.
- 2. Clear articulation of who will supervise the intern to ensure a meaningful, substantive learning opportunity that achieves relevant skills and knowledge consistent with the spirit of workforce development.
- 3. The proposed timing for the internship (anticipated start date; commitment of student hours to the internship).
- 4. What the outcome/deliverable is anticipated to be. NOTE: interns will present a brief overview at the next All Hands meeting.
